

Our moringa oil begins its journey in the Matsangoni area, Kenya. Here the Moringa oleifera tree, known as the 'Miracle Tree', thrives in dry, challenging conditions. Small farming families cultivate moringa as part of their livelihoods, drawing on generations of knowledge to care for this extraordinary crop.

In partnership with Kilifi Moringa, we've built a fully traceable supply chain that supports local farmers while ensuring consistently high quality. The seeds grow in long, slender pods and are harvested by hand. Before pressing, they are carefully cleaned. Each seed contains more than 30% oil.





From seed to skin

Our moringa oil is prized in cosmetics for its exceptional ability to nourish and protect. Naturally high in omega fatty acids, vitamin E, and antioxidants, it deeply moisturises the skin while helping to combat environmental stress. It absorbs quickly, leaving no greasy residue, and is a trusted ingredient in serums, lotions, and hair treatments.

More than oil

In 2024, part of our team visited the farmers and production sites in Matsangoni, Kenya. Seeing the impact of this crop on the local community reaffirmed our commitment to this partnership. Moringa trees grow well without intensive irrigation, making them a sustainable and reliable source of income for small-scale growers.



By staying close to the source, we ensure that every drop of moringa oil we produce carries not just quality, but also a positive story, transparency, long-term value and strong partnerships.
